A Congregational meeting will be held on Sunday October 20 immediately following the morning worship service. A membership vote will be held to get approval to offer the position of Associate Minister to Leanna Rierson. If approval is received, the board will commence the process of obtaining a work Visa to hire Leanna, initially for a two year period, commencing in June 2020.

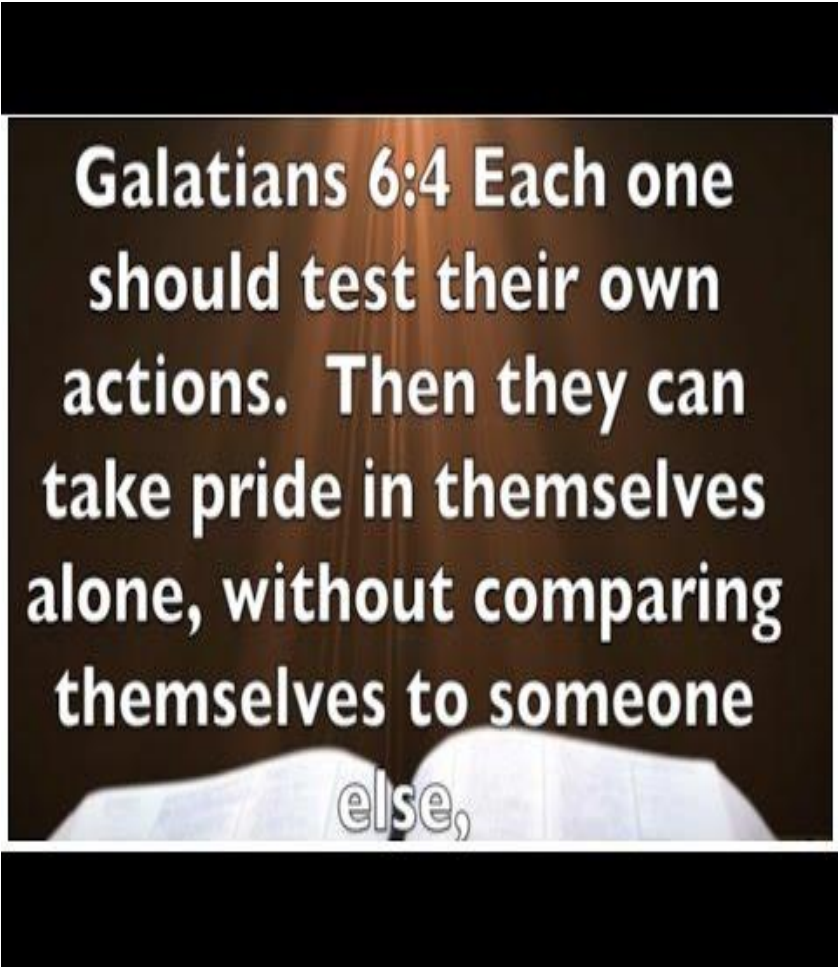
